The Milano Welcome Center offers guidance and support to the migrant and refugee population living in Milano – both individuals and families - with a focus on those newly arrived. The Center promotes services to foster integration and social inclusion, migrants' active participation in the city, as well as the protection of the rights of non-Italian nationals.

The Milano Welcome Center also offers targeted support and specialist advice to external services, professionals and local bodies in supporting people with a migrant background.

The Milano Welcome Center promotes the reception of asylum seekers and holders of international, temporary and special protection. It also actively supports refugees' social inclusion through the SAI network (the national Reception & Integration System for refugees), along with other local services and social projects.

The Milano Welcome Center was created as part of the co-design of the city's migrants' reception and social integration system, in partnership with 40 third-sector organisations.
